Dear Friends,

Welcome/welcome back to *KADIMAH* (“moving forward”)! This Jewish learning program is designed specifically for our 7th through 12th graders. It features an informal atmosphere that addresses the needs of the young Reform Jew living in a secular world. As you’ll see from the enclosed registration form, general categories allow each program participant to choose topics of the greatest interest to them. This list will be a guideline for us when we decide what can be offered throughout the year. Before school starts or on our first night of class your child will receive a list of specific electives for the fall of 2018 from which to choose.

We are excited to welcome **Rabbi Ilana Schwartzman** to our Kadimah teaching staff! **For core (first period of the evening) this year, Rabbi Ilana will be working with the 8th graders**, but her electives will be available to all.

If your son or daughter was enrolled in *KADIMAH* last year, you know how important these programs can be; *KADIMAH* promises to offer an even greater array of fun and exciting possibilities. If your child has not been to religious school in a while, you can rest assured that he or she will feel comfortable with our inclusive programming which assumes nothing more than an open mind and a willingness to explore, learn, and make new friends.

In addition to a school calendar, attached you will find (in both Word and pdf formats) all of the forms that we need in order to process your child's registration:

- an application which contains an area for the students to complete, and a separate form for the parent/guardian to complete
- a Covenant of Conduct form
- a fee schedule
- a confidential information form

Please note: all students are required to attend 7th grade in keeping with school policy.

We ask that you read the information carefully, and complete and return your child's application as soon as possible so that we can continue to put together an outstanding school program. If your child is away at camp, please return the main registration form and send back the Covenant of Conduct and interest forms after they fill them out. Forms can be completed as Word documents and returned to us via email if using a credit card, or the pdf forms can also be printed and mailed or faxed to the synagogue. If you are not comfortable sending your credit card number via email or fax, you may call it in to the office. **If you have a credit card on file and wish to use that one, simply put “use card on file” on your form. Paper forms will be sent if you need them; just ask!**

Information about our trip to **Washington, D.C.** for students in grades 10-12 is included in the registration form. This trip will take place February 22 - 25, 2019. We look forward to continuing your son/daughter's bond with our congregation through our outstanding program, and hope we can count on your participation as well in making our school continue in strength.

Kadimah meets **MONDAY** evenings, 6:45 – 8:30 pm. The tuition fee for grades 7–12 is \$675.00 for Beth Haverim Shir Shalom members. Students in grade 8 through 12 whose families are not members of Beth Haverim Shir Shalom are eligible to take part in KADIMAH. Non-member tuition is \$775.00.

Payment Options: If paying in full, school fees may be paid by credit card or check made payable to “BHSS.” If you are using the “two payment” plan, your card will not be charged before August 15. If paying in two payments, payment must be made by credit card AND both payment boxes below must be completed. We will start forming classes midsummer, so please send in the forms as soon as possible.

Kadimah meets on Monday evenings from 6:45 - 8:30 p.m. Typically, the beginning part of the evening contains "core" classes, which are taught to grade level groups.

After core is pizza break. During that time we also make any important announcements, students who are working on a community service project and would like to describe it to their peers have an opportunity then. At that time also we celebrate anyone who became bar or bat mitzvah the previous weekend and cheer on anyone becoming bar or bat mitzvah the following weekend!

After pizza is electives. Approximately 4 times a year, we will distribute via hard copy or email (or both) an "Elective Choice Form," which is to be filled out with student's top three choices and returned. Based on those forms, students are assigned electives. The electives usually run 5 sessions, so there is time during the year for someone to have 4 different electives. We try to give everyone one of their first three choices, whenever possible.

In an effort to realize the expectations that you as parents and we as a school have set forth for your child's religious education, we have established the following Brit Derech Eretz (Covenant of Conduct), to be signed by both parent and student. Please discuss this with your child before signing.

Any student who disrupts school by engaging in physical contact with other students, unwarranted "speaking out" in class, use of foul language, misuse of the building or its furnishings, or any other behavior found unacceptable by a staff member, the education director, the cantor, or the rabbi, will be asked to leave the class. In this event, a parent will be contacted, and may be asked to escort the student home for the remainder of the session.

If this behavior persists during subsequent school sessions, the student and his/her parent(s) will be asked to meet with a representative of Beth Haverim Shir Shalom's Board of Trustees, the education director, and the rabbi, to discuss the child's status in our religious school.
