

We are looking forward to seeing everyone at our first sessions of school!

Attached is a calendar for the year. You will see that some of the Mondays have a *, which is “pj remote”. This refers **only to Kadimah classes (7th-12th grade.)**

Arrival: Students are expected to be dropped off by the education entrance of the main BHSS building with masks on - early enough for class to begin promptly, their parent having filled out a health form ahead of time (see below.) **Our 6th grade traditional classes on Sunday mornings** will take place in the **ULAM**, which is the newer building at the end of the parking lot. Traditional 6th graders should be **dropped directly there**, and picked up from there promptly at 10:30 a.m.

The following procedure is in place to help to ensure that any exposures to COVID will be disclosed. Please bookmark the Google form that MUST be filled out and received by the school EACH WEEK NO LATER than:

A form is not required for students enrolled for any trimester of **remote class**.

If we **DO NOT RECEIVE** a form for your child and they are dropped off at school, the student **will not be allowed to attend class**, and we will contact you to return to pick them up. Students will need to wait in an unused, monitored room while during that time.

If a public school **determines** that a student or students **must quarantine**, and **this affects 4 or more students in one of our grades**, that grade will be held via Zoom on its regularly scheduled day and time until the quarantine period is over. Please be mindful of everyone's safety and report quarantine conditions affecting your child as soon as possible.

Note that we are modifying our normal sick policies to take special consideration in an effort to reduce the risk of possible infection. We cannot emphasize enough the need for our parents to keep children home when they are sick.

Illness once in school:

If a child begins to display symptoms of illness while at school including, but not limited to fever, coughing, sneezing, runny nose, and/or headache, they will be removed from the

classroom and assigned to an unused but monitored room until they can be picked up. Parents will be notified and required to pick up their child immediately. Emergency contacts will be called if your child is not picked up within 15 minutes.

Dismissal procedures: As always, parents will need to park their cars and come to the building to pick up students; students are not allowed to walk through the parking lot without their driver. **You must wear a mask to enter the building.**

- On **Sundays**, traditional grade 6 students and Family School will dismiss at the same time, since they are coming from two different buildings.
- On **Monday afternoons**, students in grades K/1 and 2 will be dismissed from their rooms to the school exit first. When most are out the building, grade 3 will be dismissed from their area. (If you have children in both groups, we will arrange for them to leave together.) On **Monday evenings** all Kadimah students will be dismissed at the same time.
- On **Tuesdays**, students in grade 4 will be dismissed from their room promptly at 5:45 p.m. When most are out of the building, we will send grade 5 out.

At this time, we do not plan for any food or drink to be consumed while the students are in the building. Please ensure that students eat a snack before afternoon sessions and breakfast before Sunday morning sessions.

The school staff and I have been very busy all summer getting ready - we can't wait to see your children and you!
